

LOGISTICS OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT NVQ LEVEL 3

To achieve this qualification, the candidate must complete 8 of the 18 Units.
(All 3 Mandatory Units, plus the appropriate combination of 5 Optional Units)

MANDATORY UNITS

- Identify the Logistics Requirements of a Supply Chain
- Promote and Maintain Health, Safety and Security in Logistics Operations
- Promote Compliance of Logistics Operations with Legislation, Regulations and Organisational Procedures

OPTIONAL UNITS

Candidates must take a minimum of one Unit from Group A and Group B.
3 other Units to be taken from Group A, B and C.
A maximum of 3 Units from each Group can be taken.

Group A (minimum of 1 unit up to a maximum of 3)

- Schedule Logistics Operations to Meet Customer Requirements
- Optimise the Use of Logistics Resources
- Develop Contingency Plans for Logistics Operations
- Utilise Transport Modes in Logistics Operations
- Apply Technology in Logistics Operations

Group B (minimum of 1 unit up to a maximum of 3)

- Develop Relationships with Logistics Customers
- Improve the Quality of Logistics Operations
- Respond to Contingencies during Logistics Operations
- Monitor the Environmental Impact of Logistics Operations

Group C (Specialist and Management units, maximum of 3 units)

International Logistics Operations units

- Arrange the transportation of goods using multiple transport modes
- Organise the preparation of documentation for the transportation of goods

Warehousing and Storage units

- Manage the receipt, storage, or dispatch of goods
- Audit stock levels and stock records

Management and Leadership units

- Provide leadership for your team
- Allocate and check work in your team
